Principal's Message

Although postponed due to the recent snowstorm, our celebration of Catholic Schools Week was a wonderful experience for students, faculty, and staff. I wish to thank Ms. Mallon, the members of the planning committee, and the PTO for organizing all of the details. Undeterred by the delays related to inclement weather, they worked diligently to ensure that our school community enjoyed this annual celebration of our Catholic heritage and mission.

This week I wish to provide an update regarding our safety and security measures. Next Wednesday, February 18, our students will attend Ash Wednesday Mass at 10:00 a.m. Because of the large number of parishioners who attend daily Mass on Ash Wednesday, it has been our tradition for many years to have a separate Mass for the school.

In an effort to further enhance our security, please note that Ash Wednesday Mass for the school will be a “closed event”, meaning that only students, faculty, and staff will be permitted to attend the Mass. As

such, parents who have participated in this school Mass in prior years are invited to attend another parish Mass that day.

Similarly, Stations of the Cross as well as Adoration & Benediction for the school community during Lent will also be “closed events” with only students, faculty, and staff in attendance.

Please note that these changes are not in response to a specific concern. Rather, they present an opportunity to tighten security for school events that occur within a liturgical season during which there are typically more visitors to the church.

I will continue to keep you apprised of any changes and updates to our school safety and security plan. In the meantime, should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know.


