Report Cards

Report cards and awards for Grades 1-7 will be issued on the final day of school, June 12. Since the office will have a record of your child's final grades at the close of the year, you may retain these cards.

Reminders from the Nurse

Medication pick up will be available the last two days of school. Please check in with Mrs. Kruppa before going to the nurse's office to pick up any medication. Any remaining medication will be kept at the front desk until end of the day Monday, June 15 and then disposed of, in accordance with diocesan policy.

Please remember that rising 7th Graders will need the mandatory Meningococcal and Tdap vaccines for entry to the new school year. All rising Kindergartners will need a new School Health Entrance Form and mandatory immunizations for the new school year. Please discuss these with your child's primary care physician.

NOTE: Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students require a new School Health Entrance Form **before** the first day of school. **ALL** grades need to submit a Confidential Health History form (F1-A), and **ALL** grades should provide an updated School Health Entrance form when there are pertinent medical changes.
